GOOD MORNING!

The school's front door opens at **8.45am** when school begins. Please encourage the children to come into school quietly. The children **must not** run around in the corridors, climb on the window sills or on cloakroom benches and chairs. Please do not allow your child to touch the piano in the cloakroom.

From your child's third day at school they will stay from **8.45-10.30am**. The home time will be extended until **11.15am** from **Monday 19 September**. Then further extended to **11.45am** from **Monday 26 September**.

COLLECTING ON TIME

Please be punctual -our children do not like to be kept waiting, particularly at the beginning of the year.



Please make sure we have the names of all adults likely to collect your child from school and if there is change to the list any day please write details in the book in the main corridor.

This year we welcome a tank full of little fish which our helpers will care for and feed each day. Our two goldfish need names – if your child would like to think of names please write on a piece of paper and place in the nursery fund box in the main corridor.

Nursery Fund

Nursery fund for the month of September will be **£10** if your child **begins 30 Aug, £7.50** if they start **5 Sept** and **£5** if they start on **12 September**. From **3 Oct** it will be **£12** per month. You can purchase money envelopes for £2.50 from the office in the Nursery – ask a member of staff. Please place labelled money envelopes in the nursery fund box – **please do not hand money to a member of staff!**

WORK TRAYS



As you come into the main classroom each child has their own named work tray in which to keep their work and also our notes and letters for you. Please check your child's work tray **daily** otherwise you may miss something important! If your child is being collected by someone else please remind them to check the work trays for you.

Please make sure that all your child's clothing is clearly named, including shoes, wellies and coats. Show your child where the label / name is!
