find these useful to have.

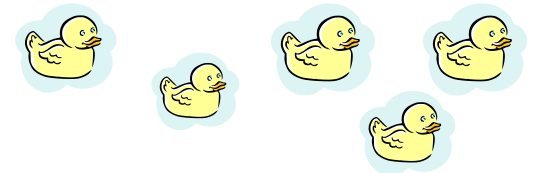
Five Fat Peas
